CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Ray Sloss.

- Carl reported that as of April 18th, 2015 we had a Bank Balance of \$117,238.80 (includes Checking, Protection Fund Checking, and Savings) and payment of Claims totaling \$10,668.87 for the period March 22nd thru April 18th, 2015.

• AQUATIC PLANT CONTROL: (Rod / Carl)

- Herbicide Treatment (Carl)

 \circ Noted that all the involved people are engaged and ready when the conditions are suitable. Water temp 50 - 60 degrees and quiet.

- Harvesting (Rod)

- Noted meeting with DNR that was very positive and open to a trial test of areas yet to be defined.
- o Noted that equipment options including rent, buy, and or borrow.
- Continued contact with other lake groups that have done harvesting to blend into our lake situation. CLP herbicide treated areas would not be candidates for harvesting
- o Navigation is also a consideration with DNR approval.

• CLEAN BOATS CLEAN WATER: (Carl)

- Training was held on April 11th with small attendance.
- Ready to start on Fishing opener May 2nd.

• DOCKSIDE NEWSLETTER: (Ray)

- The Spring Dockside is out and the next issue with annual meeting information will be out July 1st.
- Ray noted that added cost; however everyone agreed the quality is good and to continue as is.
 Will address the increased production cost with the next budget cycle.

• PUBLIC APPOINTMENTS:

Balsam Lake Village: (Glen)

- Noted that the Village has approved a Dam inspection by Ayres Corp.

Polk County: (Carl)

- Noted that County is working with a resolution for Gandy Dancer to approve some motorized use (special permit) to equal Minnesota laws.
