AQUATIC PLANT CONTROL: (Rod / Carl)

Carl provided update regarding Herbicide application noting that he is working with Cheryl Clemens to submit necessary grant documents for years 2015 – 2017. Also noted was:

- Proposals received from Matt Berg regarding Pre-post treatment surveys, CLP Bed mapping, landing inspections, and Turion density survey. Noting that no increase in cost.
- Noted that herbicide application rate was discussed and recommendation received was to decrease the dosage to lessen impact on the native plants. After discussion; the board felt the need to keep the option open for any rate needed to perform adequate CLP control.
- Also noted discussion to consider native plantings in treated CLP beds.
