## 6. PUBLIC COMMENTS:

- Chris updated on county happenings
- Paul Duxbury requests agenda be posted before the monthly meetings so
  people can decide whether or not they want to come. He cited a Wisconsin
  statute requiring this. Tom says this is a logical request, what would be involved
  in posting it on the website. Ed noted village agenda is posted in 3 places for
  every meeting. Tom believed it could just be posted on the website. Ray will
  research the statute to note whether it needs to be physically posted. Tom
  noted for April meeting and moving forward it will be posted on the website
  with at least 48 hours in advance. Rod can post it physically. Ray to inform in
  April.

- Balance forward into protection fund 165090.35
- Tom asked if protection fund detail should be on the balance sheet
- Need to break out income and expense to reflect interest paid on load from Feb income and Expense sheet
- Clarification –tax levy comes into operating budget. Left over money is transferred into protection fund annually in February or March. Most municipalities pay in Jan/Feb or July/August
- 3 loans:

- Rice Creek Sedimentation, AIS Rapid Response and building currently unfunded.
   Need to allocation dollars to specific funds. Tom wants to wait until all commissioners are present

#### 9. WATER RUNOFF PROGRAM

- Water Quality no discussion
- East Balsam Study / McGlynn (not present, update in April)
- Sedimentation Dredging / Preble
  - i. (working on permits, need picture of each bay with someone standing by them to get a size perspective, need after ice is out) Rod have a conference call with Dale Erbach is working on the permits on behalf of the BLPRD to make sure we aren't missing something. Ray noted we do not have a project yet for the dredging and can't spend money until we have that noted and budgeted. Tom noted the project is dredging in 3 bays. Rod will work with Dale to create a project plan. Ray: need to understand how funding will work. Rod noted this is phosphorous removal. Need to clarify how it will be paid and for what parts. Project plan should address not just the 3 bays but also other future areas. Don't know yet is we need a 2 point cable system or a self propelled dredger. Rod action item: will scope out which potential areas the cable system would handle. Rod to complete the project plan for this.
  - ii. Tom app \$6 million spent to dredge a similar lake to East Balsam (Wonder Lake).
  - iii. Clippings: Rod trying to reach person who has a gully to discuss putting dredge material on his land. This is preferred vs. putting in bags.
  - iv. Aeration possibly needs to be researched as well. Rod noted iron seeding is another possibility to bring in to address blue green algae.
     East Balsam use of this might be a possibility. It may be materially less expensive than Alum. Need more information on aeration
- Healthy Lakes Native Plantings / Kelly
  - i. Nothing new. Training session at Lakes Conference, Tom will attend
  - ii. We should hear this month whether we got the grant
- Aquatic Plant Management
  - CLP treatment / Sloss-Preble

- 1. Permit has gone in, waiting for response
- 2. Public Notices in process
- 3. Once ice comes off lake, we start watching temperature

## ii. CBCW / Sloss -

- 1. 2 individuals secured this year
- 2. Will be cutting back on hours to bring us back into budget. 200 hours per landing. Tom: voted to fund more for the program
- 3. April hopefully Bass Club guy can come in April to discuss management for fishing tournament
- iii. Harvester / Preble
- Harvester Building
  - i. Presentation from Chris Nelson re: Harvester Building bids. Building bid was reviewed. We need to review how the approval was worded to determine limitations on building costs. Over the approved limit, will need to review how the approval at the annual meeting is worded to determine how it is worded. Total bid is \$49,172 does not include electrical or electric relocation.
- Rod changed permit to only list beach are, not Perry Mound. Perry Mound is not approved yet. We will inspect with the DNR this summer to determine if it qualifies.
- Truck will have maintenance work done in April
- GPS testing will happen in April
- Lease with City
  - i. Lease agreement attorney working on it
- AIS Rapid Response
  - i. To be discussed next month
- Conservancies
  - i. Ray will work on sign replacement
